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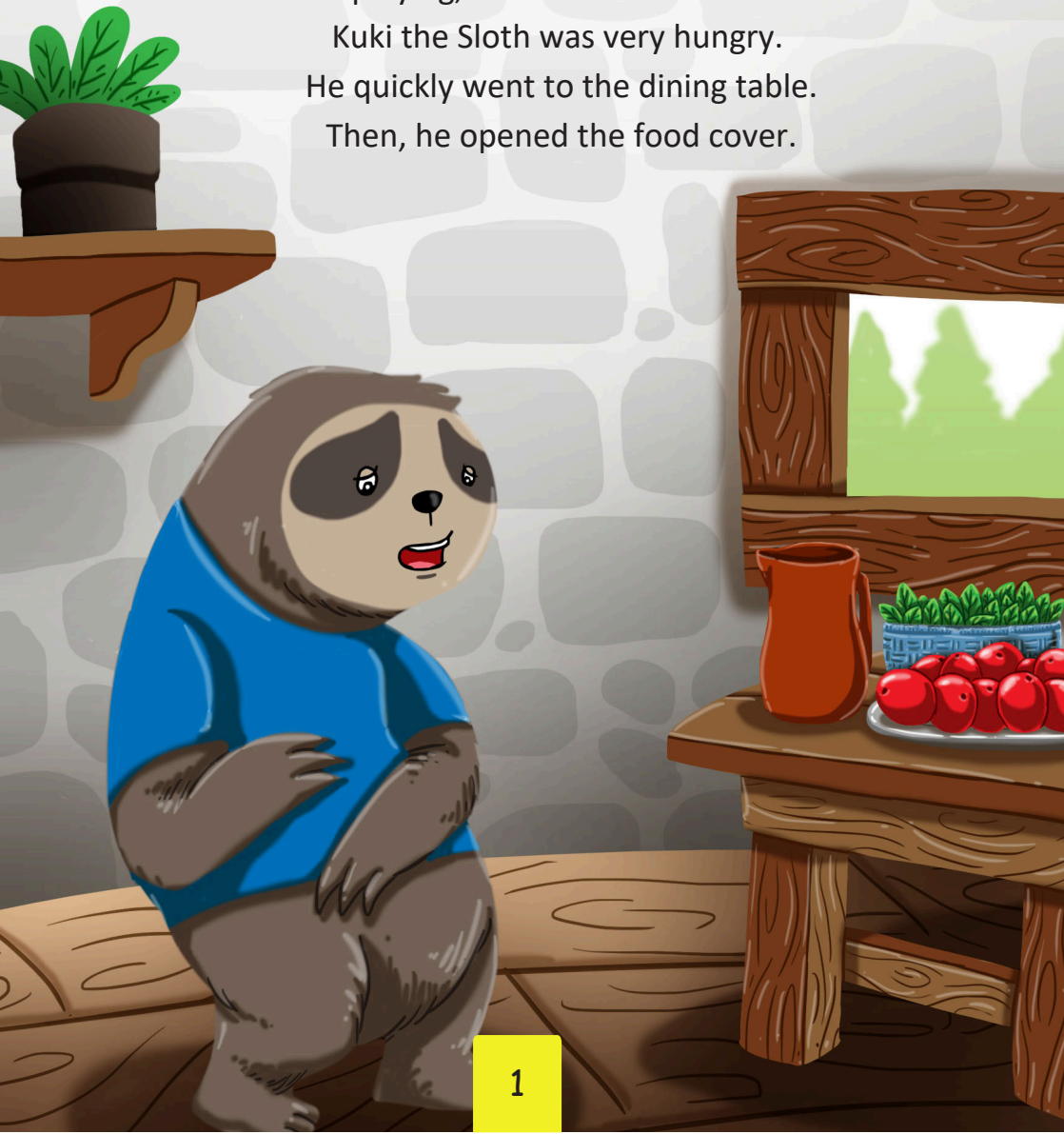
***Bar dolanan, Kuki Kungkang bali.

Ana pulut kayu karo endhog.

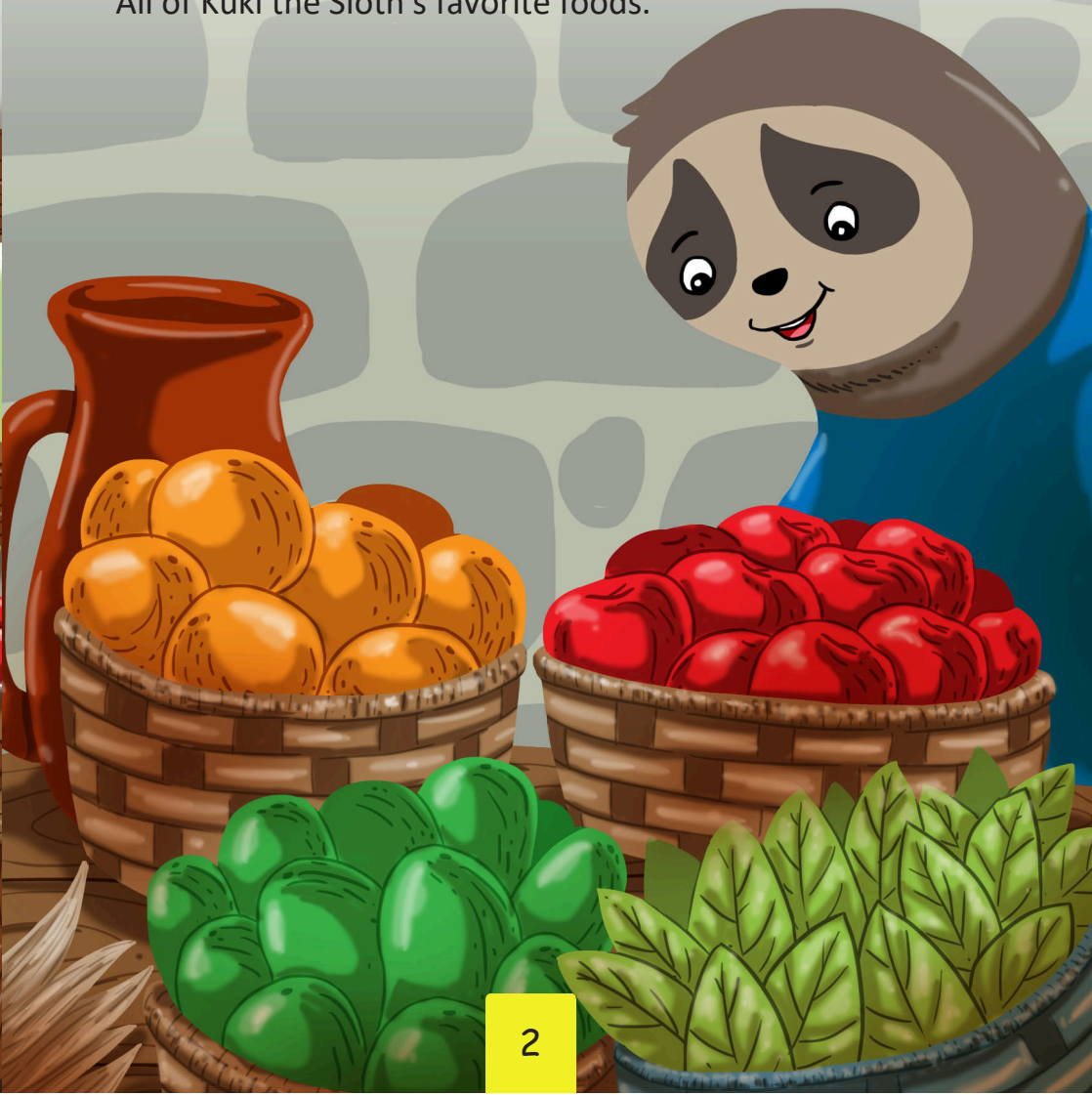
Kabeh panganan kesenengane Kuki Kungkang.

It hurt so much.



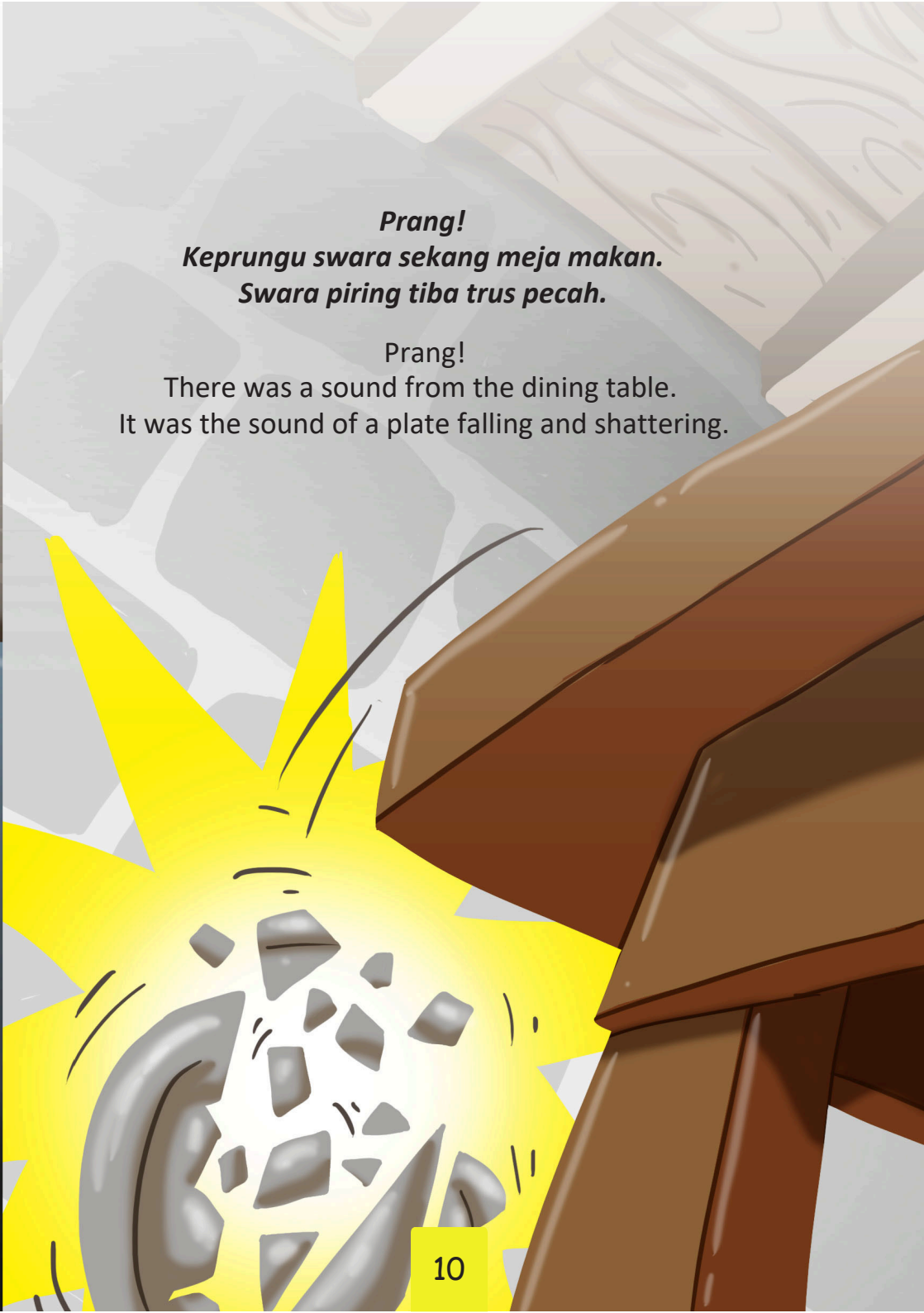
***Kuki Kungkang mlebu meng kamar.
